

BIOMARKER STUDY FOR THE TREATMENT RESPONSE IN ATTENTION DEFICIT HYPERACTIVITY DISORDER (ADHD)

Do you think your child may have ADHD?

The aim of this research study is to identify physical and psychological markers that predict treatment response to a stimulant medication in children diagnosed with ADHD.

This research study is for male or female individuals who are:

- 6-17 years of age
- Experiencing symptoms of ADHD (e.g. problems paying attention, hyperactivity, impulsivity) and;
- Fluent and literate in English

Your child will be required to satisfy study criteria and attend a medical screening and clinical assessment before being permitted to participate in the study.

- The research study will involve two 6-7 hour testing sessions and two additional phone and internet follow-up sessions.
- Your child will be asked to provide a saliva sample, answer questions and perform various tasks (e.g. memory recall) while their brain activity is measured.
- You may be asked to help your child complete some of the assessments.
- You may be compensated for your time participating in this research study.
